First Confession and First Communion Registration

Preparation for the sacraments is parish based. This means that children from Catholic, public and private schools are prepared together. As outlined in the Sacramental Norms of the Archdiocese of Toronto, the following are the requirements needed to prepare a child for the sacraments of Reconciliation and Eucharist:

- ✧ Baptism in a Catholic Church
- ✧ Aged 7 years or older
- ✧ Regular participation at Mass on Sundays
- ✧ At least one year of religious education (catechism) as provided by the Catholic schools system or enrolment in our parish religious education programme.

A Parent Meeting will be held on Wednesday, October 8th at 7:15 P.M. in the Church.

Registration will take place at this meeting. It is essential that parents (not children) attend this meeting. If you are unable to attend, please contact the parish office before this date. Children not registered on time will celebrate these sacraments next school year.

Please bring the following to the meeting:

- ✧ **A copy of the child's baptismal certificate if he/she was not baptized at St. Theresa's Church.**
- ✧ **\$20 for books and materials**

An individual parent meeting with the pastor is also an integral part in the Sacramental preparation. Please be ready to book a date (before December 10th) for your meeting with Fr. Florentine.

Stained Glass Jubilee Project

New frame and stained glass for the oval window in the vestibule is a special parish jubilee project. It will be a constant reminder for the generations to come of a concerted effort by the whole community of St. Theresa for the blessings since the foundation of the church 75 years ago.
