Triumph of the Cross

Feast Day: Today, September 14th

On this day, let us reflect on how Jesus Christ triumphed over death by his resurrection. Two thousand years ago, Jesus trusted God and chose hope over death, resulting in triumph of love over hate and faith over despair. Today, each of us also has a choice. When we are faced with adversity, we can choose not to let hate or despair overtake us. As we struggle with the crosses in our own lives, we too can choose to make love and faith triumphant in the world.


