#### Fifth Week of Lent

**A life of Faith.** Your faith in God is the foundation for trusting yourself and others – and for renewing your life.

✧ Share your faith. Tell others about the Good News of Jesus Christ. Think about how you can spread the Gospel.

✧ Improve a neglected talent. Set aside some time to paint, knit, etc.

Exchange skills: teach others a skill in exchange for their teaching you one.

Mar. 10 – Reflect on people who've trusted you and those whom you've trusted.

Mar. 11 – Pray for God to strengthen your faith.

Mar. 12 – Talk with family and friends about ways to improve trust.

Mar. 13 – Let a child, youth or friend plan all your activities today.

Mar. 14 – Write about your faith in your Lenten diary. What makes it strong?

Mar. 15 – Take a nature walk and look for signs of new life.
