Christ's Body and Blood in the Sacrament of Holy Communion are our true food as Christians, giving us the strength to live our lives in union with God.



Short Novena for Corpus Christi

O Lord Jesus Christ, You who have given us Your precious Body and Blood to be our meat and drink, grant that through frequent reception of You in the Holy Eucharist, I may be strengthened in mind and body to do Your holy will. Amen.

Solemnity of The Sacred Heart of Jesus

Feast: Friday, June 11th

There will be a Festive Mass at 7:15 p.m.

"... Practicing devotion to the Sacred Heart of Christ means adoring that Heart which, after having loved us to the end, was pierced by a spear and from high on the Cross poured out blood and water, an inexhaustible source of new life.



The feast of the Sacred Heart is also World Day for the Sanctification of Priests, a favorable opportunity to pray that priests will put nothing before love of Christ. Blessed Bishop Giovanni Battista Scalabrini, patron of migrants, was deeply devoted to the Heart of Christ;

...In recalling this great Bishop, I turn my thoughts to those who are far from their homeland and also often from their family, and I hope that on their way they will always meet friendly faces and welcoming hearts that can sustain them in the difficulties of daily life.

The heart that resembles that of Christ more than any other is without a doubt the Heart of Mary, his Immaculate Mother, and for this very reason the liturgy holds them up together for our veneration.

Responding to the Virgin's invitation at Fatima, let us entrust the whole world to her Immaculate Heart, so that it may experience the merciful love of God and know true peace."

Year of the Priest Concludes

Catholics worldwide are urged to pray for priests on June 11th, the World Day of Prayer for Priests. The day was begun by Pope John Paul II in 2002 with the objective of having all Catholic faithful join in prayer for the sanctification of priests. The World Day of Prayer for Priests coincides with the feast of the Sacred Heart of Jesus. This year it also concludes the year of the Priest begun on the feast of the Sacred Heart in 2009.



To commemorate the conclusion of the Year of the Priests, Pope Benedict XVI will lead a celebration in Rome on June 11th with thousands of priests from around the world in attendance.

In Toronto, the Archdiocese will mark the closing with a Holy Hour and Eucharistic Celebration on Friday, June 11th at St. Michael's Cathedral from 1:00-3:00 PM. Archbishop Thomas Collins will preside with priests from throughout the Archdiocese in attendance. A reception with light refreshments will follow in the Cathedral Courtyard. Join us as we offer prayer and thanksgiving for the clergy who faithfully serve the people of the Archdiocese of Toronto.
